Notice is hereby given that South Kesteven District Council formally adopted the Greyfriars and Wharf Place Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs) on the 9th January 2012.

The purpose of the Greyfriars and Wharf Place SPDs is to supplement policies contained in the Council's Development Plan and set out planning and development principles that will be used to guide the development and regeneration of the sites for mixed use development.

The SPDs are part of South Kesteven District Council's Local Development Framework and will be a material consideration in the determination of planning applications.

Copies of the adopted Greyfriars and Wharf Place SPDs, statement summarising the main issues raised during the formal consultation and how these were addressed in finalising the SPDs and all supporting documents are available for inspection on the Council's website www.southkesteven.gov.uk/index.aspx?articleid=2943 and at the locations listed below.

Any person aggrieved by the adoption of the Greyfriars and Wharf Place SPDs may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the SPDs. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPDs were adopted.
