



Are you living in overcrowded accommodation?

Whether or not you are 'overcrowded' depends on the size of your home as well as who lives with you. In order for us to decide whether you should be awarded a rehousing priority, we need to assess whether you are "overcrowded" based on a room standard and space standards set out in the Housing Act 1985 part X.

If your current accommodation is overcrowded when compared to these standards, this is known as statutory overcrowding. *This standard only applies to people who do not share living space with people from another household.* It is important for us to have details about your household and all the rooms available to you (do not include details about Kitchen, Bathroom or toilet).
