

# Rectory Farm Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

## Adoption Statement

In accordance with [The Town and Country Planning \(Local Planning\) \(England\) Regulations 2012](#) this statement gives notice that South Kesteven District Council adopted the Rectory Farm Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on **25 November 2021**. The SPD supplements Policy GR3-H2 (and other policies as detailed in the SPD) of the [Local Plan \(2020\)](#) to provide the policy basis to ensure that the Council is able to deliver a high quality and well designed development at Rectory Farm, with homes to meet the needs of our residents whilst creating healthy and strong communities. It will assist the Council in delivering its ambition to create a Clean and Sustainable Environment and meet Climate Change objectives

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and, in any event, no later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
