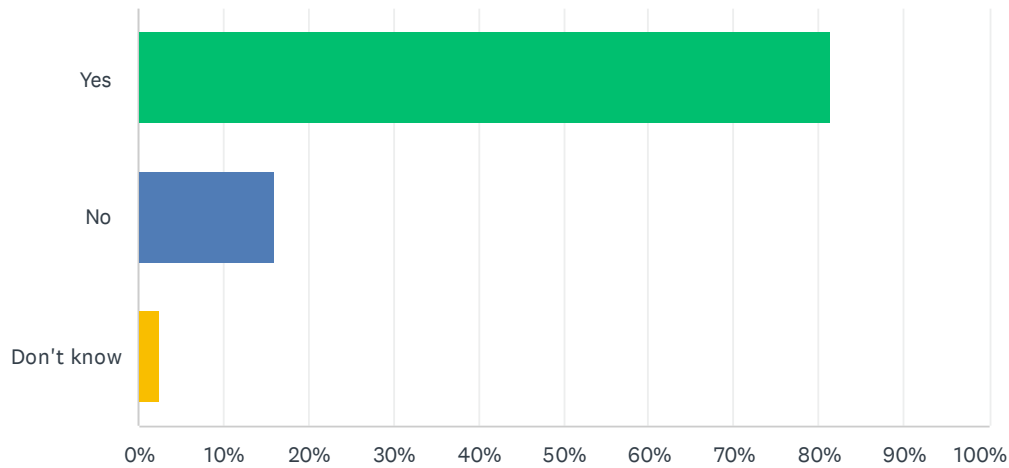


Q1 Do you agree with South Kesteven District Council's draft recommendation that a Town Council should be set up to serve the town of Grantham?

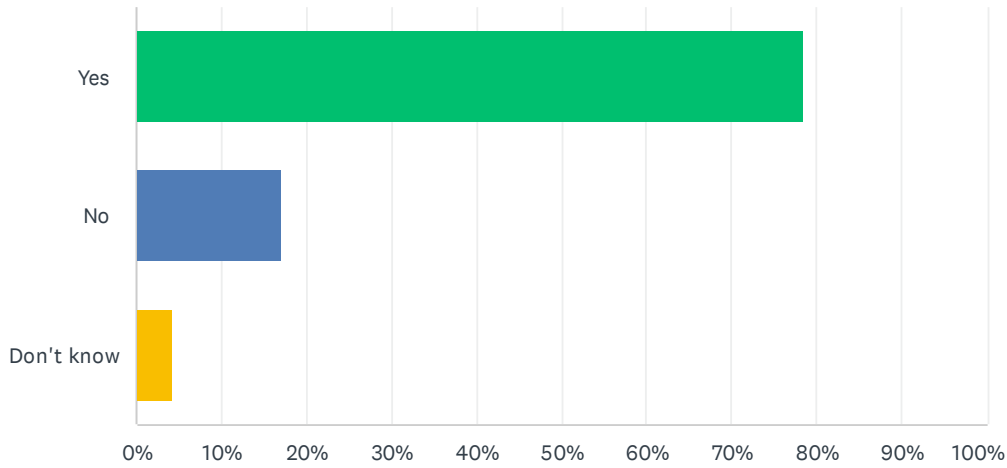

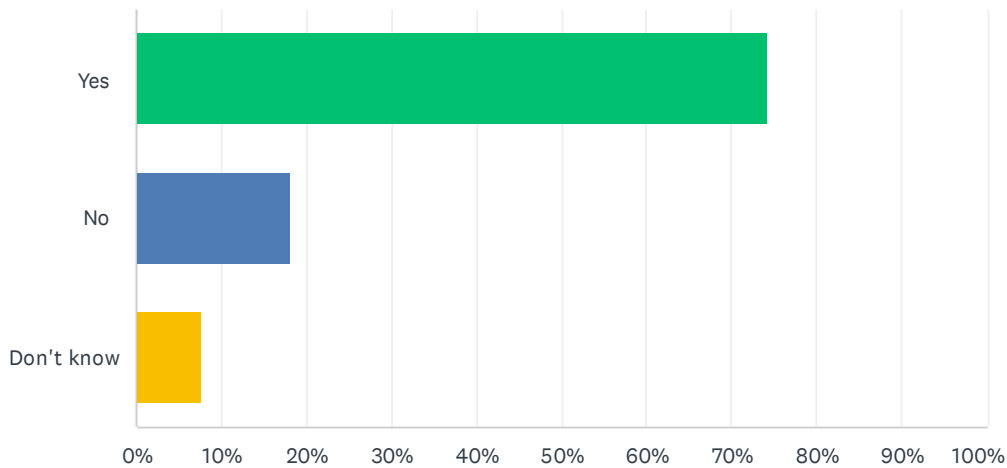
