

# REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICT, POLLING PLACES AND POLLING STATIONS 2023 PROPOSED POLLING ARRANGEMENTS – OCTOBER 2023

#### **Current Parliamentary Constituencies:**

- Grantham and Stamford
- Sleaford and North Hykeham
- South Holland and the Deepings

## **Future Parliamentary Constituencies (from next General election):**

- Grantham and Bourne
- Rutland and Stamford
- South Holland and the Deepings

#### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1. Scope of the review

This review will consider the polling district boundaries and designated polling places across South Kesteven. This review will not consider changes to the district boundary, Parliamentary constituency boundaries or ward boundaries.

#### 1.2. Reason for this review

The Council is responsible for reviewing polling districts and places for the Parliamentary constituencies within its boundary. These boundaries and polling places are also used for local elections. The Council is required to undertake compulsory reviews every five years. The Council is required to complete the next compulsory review between October 2023 and January 2025.

The Boundary Commission for England has published the final recommendation for the future Parliamentary constituencies and these new revised constituencies will come into force at the next General election. The next General election must take place by January 2025 and it is therefore necessary to undertake the compulsory review now to ensure the most suitable polling places are designated.

#### 1.3. Methodology

We must comply with certain requirements when conducting the review:

- We must ensure that there is a separate polling district for each
- We must seek to ensure that all electors have such reasonable facilities for voting as are practicable
- So far as is reasonable and practicable every polling place should be accessible to electors who have a disability
- A polling place must be designated for each polling district, unless the circumstances of a polling district are such that the location does not materially affect the convenience of the electors
- The polling place should be an area in the district, unless circumstances make it desirable to designate an area wholly or partly outside the district
- The (Acting) Returning Officer must comment on the existing and proposed arrangements and allocate electors to polling stations.
- The Electoral Commission recommends that no more than 2,250 electors are allocated to a polling station.
- Consideration of ward and polling district boundaries and that they are reasonable accessible, following natural
  boundaries, have transport links, and avoid barriers such as steep hills, major roads, railway lines or rivers

#### 1.4. Terminology

A polling district is the geographical area created by sub-dividing a constituency or ward.

A **polling place** is the building or area in which a polling station is located.

A **polling station** is the actual room or area where voting takes place.

We would particularly encourage any comments about the accessibility of polling station voting to voters with any type of disability, either at specific polling places, or in general.

#### 2 Current and proposed arrangements

#### 2.1 Polling district references

The current polling districts include references to the Parliamentary constituencies with the suffix of '1' used to indicate the current Grantham and Stamford constituency, '2' for the Sleaford and North Hykeham constituency and '3' indicates the South Holland and the Deepings constituency.

New parliamentary constituencies will be implemented at the next General election which must be held by January 2025. As a result it is proposed, as part of this review, that the polling district references for some districts will be changed to reflect the new constituencies. The proposals included below propose changes to indicate the new constituencies with the suffix '1' for the new Grantham and Bourne constituency, '2' to indicate the new Rutland and Stamford constituency and '3' retained for the South Holland and the Deepings constituency.

No changes are proposed to the boundary of any polling districts.

#### 2.2 Proposed polling place arrangements

Any proposed changes to a polling places are detailed in the schedules below. For many polling districts the current polling places are considered the most appropriate locations and venues however a small number of changes are proposed. Comments on both the current and proposed polling places are welcomed as part of this review.

**DJA3** – The current polling station electorate for this polling district is 2111. Electoral Commission guidance recommends that a polling station should not have more than 2,250 electors allocated to it. The electorate in this polling district will be kept under review with an additional polling place being considered in the future.

**DJB3** – The Deeping St James Community Primary School has served as the polling place for this polling district for many years, with the exception of the 2021 elections when it was temporarily relocated to the Methodist Church during Covid measures. Due to the large number of voters registered in this polling district, there are two polling stations at this polling place. Two alternative venues in the area have been considered during this review:

- The Deepings Methodist Church, Church Street
- The Open Door Baptist Church, Spalding Road

Whilst both venues offer good facilities for use as a polling place, the Deepings Methodist Church is considered to be the most suitable venue. The Open Door Baptist Church has a suitable room which could be used with off-road car parking however the gravel car park/entrance and the busy Spalding Road could potentially be problematic at a high turnout election with cars entering and leaving the premises via the single car entrance throughout the day. In addition there is no permitted on-street parking on Spalding Road due to the close proximity to the Deepings School.

The Methodist Church provides level access, off road car parking with two entrances plus on-street car parking on Church Street. It is therefore proposed that the polling place for polling district DJB3 be relocated to the Methodist Church, Church Street, Deeping St James.

#### Initial observations/comments received

Councillor Ashley Baxter, resident and Councillor for Market and West Deeping Ward: With regard to Deeping St James (where I am a resident), if ever you did have a problem with the venue(s), I would recommend you consider the Open Door Church on Spalding Road and/or the Deepings Methodist Church on Church Street. However, election days in the Deepings seem fine as they are, and it's quite handy having two polling stations in the one building.

#### (Acting) Returning Officer further comments

**GBA1** – The suggested alternative of the car park at the back of Tesco Express on the corner of Barrowby Gate and Winchester Road was investigated during the interim review conducted in 2022. At that time it was not possible to make contact with the owner of the site. The site is in a good location within the polling district and more central to than the Bowls Club. However further enquiries have been made of Land Registry records which show that access to the car park is required at all times by all business premises and flats on the site and their visitors.

Siting of a mobile polling station would involve the majority of the car park being unavailable for a period of 3 days to allow for the siting on the day before an election and collection on the day afterwards. As a result this option cannot be pursued further. It is proposed that the polling place for polling district GBA1 together with GBB1 remain at the Bowls Club. Suggestions of any other locations within the polling district would be welcomed.

#### Initial observations/comments received

**Councillor Gareth Knight:** As I recommended in the last polling station review before I was a councillor I would like to put forward the car park at the back of Tesco Express on the corner of Barrowby Gate and Winchester Road as a suitable location for a mobile polling station to cover district GBA1.

This is central to the polling district and it makes sense for this to be used given that the bowls club is up to 32 minutes' walk from some houses in the polling district.

**GHA1** – The Church of the Ascension Hall was designated as the polling place in 2022 after being used at the 2021 elections during Covid measures and has now served as the polling place at two sets of elections. The Church Hall provides a large hall, with good access and car parking facilities. Previously electors in this polling district voted at Communal Room in Canterbury Close, which is situated on a fairly narrow road with a one-way system and limited number of parking pays. It is proposed that the polling place remain at The Church of the Ascension Hall.

**GHC1** – The Church of the Ascension Hall was designated as the polling place in 2022 and successfully used as the polling place for the May 2023 District elections. Previously voters in polling district voted at Central Place Communal Room which although within the polling district it is located at one end of the polling district, on a cul-desac with only residents parking available.
