Design Guidelines for Rutland and South Kesteven Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

Adoption Statement

In accordance with <u>The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning)</u> (England) Regulations 2012 this statement gives notice that South Kesteven District Council adopted the Design Guidelines for Rutland and South Kesteven Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 25 November 2021. The SPD supplements Policy DE1 (and other policies as detailed in the Annex of the Design Guidelines SPD) of the <u>Local Plan (2020)</u> to provide the policy basis for setting out the steps, expectations and considerations for new development proposals to follow in order to achieve a high level of design quality.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event no later than three months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
