Great Gonerby

The information provided in Consultation 1 and Consultation 2 is in no way sufficient for anyone to make an informed decision. There are discrepancies between Parish and Ward boundaries but the option to move the Ward boundaries is seemingly not included within this consultation. There is no information (that I can find) on what the intention is for the as yet unbuilt houses on Spitalgate Heath or Barrowby Edge/Lodge estates. As a resident of the Great Gonerby Parish but Arnoldfield Ward we already have a different MP to the remainder to Grantham. Again, this narrow and limited consultation doesn't address that. Furthermore, there are costs associated with a new town parish, but no information relating to what those costs are. On the basis that the information is not sufficient; and whatever decision I take would still leave my household with different MP representation (and therefore still not wholly aligned to Grantham across all forms of Government) I can only opt for the status quo to remain. I welcome further consultations that may offer greater insights and information for residents of the Grantham area.

Very happy with services at present. Do we really need another council?

I most definitely identify with Great Gonerby. I use the Post Office; I attend the church. I volunteer at St Sebastian's School. I certainly do not support a Grantham Town Council and would not wish to be subject to what may be an expensive and biased layer of bureaucracy.

The current boundary placing Pennine Way, Grampian Way, Brecon Close & Brendon Close (plus a couple of other houses) in Great Gonerby makes no sense, as the majority of this estate (Cotswold Drive, Malvern Drive etc) falls within Grantham. It is logical to have local decisions affecting the estate made by one authority, not two, and I therefore support joining the new parish/town council of Grantham.

Londonthorpe & Harrowby Without

With only one letter/vote per household when most properties have more than one adult should it be one letter /vote per adult in the property. You give very little information.

I understand that my council tax will increase by approx. £3.00 per week, other than this I cannot see any advantage to my household. I therefore elect to stay as I am. Thank you.
