Morton Conservation Area

- View in both directions along High Street with the grass verges either side of the highway contributing towards a sense of spaciousness. The easterly view towards St. John the Baptist is the most significant view in the conservation area.
- 2. Views from the High Street looking southwards through the yard towards the countryside beyond.
- 3. Views from the public footpath to the rear of Manor Farm towards open countryside and beyond towards Dyke.
- 4. View from the public footpath to the rear of Manor Farm looking towards the built up part of the village at High Street, with St. John the Baptist Church featuring in this view also.
- 5. Westerly view along Station Road with St. John the Baptist Church and Churchyard featuring strongly in this view.
- 6. Easterly view along Station Road with St. John the Baptist Church and Churchyard featuring strongly in this view.
- 7. View along High Street with the enclosing historic properties to the north side of the road and St. John the Baptist Church on the south side of the road.
- 8. View at the end of Ford Lane from the public footpath across important area of open space.
