- **11.** View from Back Lane towards open countryside across the ridge and furrow.
- **12.** View looking out of the conservation area boundary at Buckminster Lane towards open countryside and Buckminster Estate.
- **13.** View from outside the conservation area boundary at Sproxton Road towards St. James Church and surrounding historic buildings with the church spire and featuring strongly.
- **14.** View from outside the conservation area boundary at Sproxton Road towards the village green.
- **15.** View from Colsterworth Road looking into the village at the entrance to the conservation area.
