- To increase the hours for The sale of alcohol on the premises: Monday to Thursday 11:00 to 23:30 and Fridays and Saturdays 11:00 to 00:30. New years eve till 02:00
- To extend the opening hours: Monday to Thursday and Sundays 09:00 to 00:00 and Friday and Saturdays 09:00 to 01:00. New years eve till 03:00
- To amend the plan to increase the licensed area
- To remove and replace all Annex 2 and 3 conditions
